Resolution in Support of Acacia Bistro’s Great Streets Grant

WHEREAS, the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development (DMPED) is soliciting grant applications from eligible small business owners who wish to improve their place of business; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Great Streets Retail Small Business Reimbursement Grants is to support existing small businesses, attract new businesses, increase the District’s tax base, create new job opportunities for District residents, and transform emerging commercial corridors into thriving and inviting neighborhood centers; and

WHEREAS, Acacia Skylan Inc. (d/b/a “Acacia Bistro”), a full service restaurant at 4340 Connecticut Avenue, NW, is seeking a Great Streets Small Business Grant to improve its business by upgrading its interior décor and exterior design, by purchasing a new POS system, and installing a new pizza oven; and

WHEREAS, the ANC strongly supports the development and success of fine-dining establishments, such as Acacia Bistro, in the Van Ness commercial corridor; and

WHEREAS, ANC 3F believes that the improvements proposed by Acacia Bistro will draw more customers to dine there, thereby increasing foot traffic and promoting business and retail activity in the Van Ness corridor; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3F urges DMPED to award Acacia Bistro a Great Streets Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Commissioners Mary Beth Ray and Adam Tope are designated to represent ANC 3F in matters relating to this grant.

ANC 3F approved this resolution at its meeting on September 15, 2015, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining (5-0-0).
