AGENDA ITEMS

1. Motion to authorize \$3,500 to retain a consultant to review the Chick-fil-A application before the March 28 Public Space Meeting

Commissioner Ray provided an update on estimates from five separate traffic engineers and public space consultants, ranging from \$2,000 - \$5,000. One consultant in particular, a former member of the Public Space Committee, could review the materials and provide testimony if needed for an estimated cost of \$3,000. Commissioner Jakopchek asked about the scope of the

review and Commissioner Gresham asked about the timing, confirming the final report would be delivered to the Commission by Friday, March 18. Commissioner Adelstein asked about the cost and commissioners agreed to authorize a maximum of \$3,500. An ANC 3F resident spoke in strong support of the motion, noting her concerns with safety and traffic. The motion was approved by a vote of five in favor, none opposed, and none abstaining (5-0-0).

2. Other Business

Commissioner Gresham noted that Thai Pad restaurant is seeking to renew its existing liquor license, and that all other liquor licenses in 3F will also need to be renewed by the end of March. ABRA will contact licensees directly.

Commissioner Jakopchek announced that the upcoming Parks & Trails Committee meeting would be postponed, new details to be announced at the next regular ANC meeting.

Commissioner Nugent announced that the details of the upcoming election to fill the vacancy in 3F01 will be announced at the next regular ANC meeting.

Commissioner Ray circulated for comment a draft letter from the community to the Mayor opposing the proposed Chick-fil-A drive through.

These minutes were approved at a regular meeting of ANC 3F.
