

**ANC 3F RESOLUTION REQUESTING A DETERMINATION ON VISITOR PARKING
PASSES FOR RESIDENTS BEING REDISTRICTED FROM ANC 3F TO ANC 3E**

WHEREAS, DDOT has issued Visitor Parking Passes (VPP) to residents currently living in ANC 3F; and

WHEREAS, these passes specify that they are “only valid in ANC 3F” and are not due to expire until September 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, because of ANC redistricting, the ANC boundary will change as of January 1, 2013, so that hundreds of residents who have been issued passes “only valid in ANC 3F” will no longer be living in ANC 3F, but will be residents of ANC 3E, for which they have not received Visitor Parking Passes (a list of affected blocks is appended to this resolution); and

WHEREAS, on their face the passes will no longer be valid on the streets where these residents live, and their guests and visitors who use them after January 1 will be subject to receiving parking tickets, as confirmed by our police lieutenant at our ANC meeting; and


WHEREAS, the new boundary between ANC 3E and ANC 3F zigzags along several local streets, posing challenges for residents and their guests if ANC boundaries continue to be used to denote the VPP parking district:

- These small neighborhood streets are not natural parking boundaries;
- Visitors and guests do not always choose to park on the same side of the street as the residence they are visiting;
- Parking spaces are not always available on the same side of the street as the residence, nor are they always available on the same block;
- Many residents, and certainly their guests, are unaware of ANC boundaries and might park in the wrong ANC by mistake;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT ANC 3F requests that DDOT and the DC Council make a determination immediately whether to issue new Visitor Parking Passes to the residents who are being redistricted from ANC 3F to ANC 3E, and if so, to issue the new passes before January 1, 2013, so that visitors do not get ticketed simply because the boundary has changed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT if a decision is made not to issue new Visitor Parking Passes until the existing passes expire, ANC 3F requests that DDOT and all District parking enforcement agencies agree on a firm procedure to ensure that tickets are not issued to those who use the existing passes, and that ANC 3F and all affected residents be fully informed of this procedure.

Adopted Monday, November 19, 2012, by a vote of 7-0-0 at a duly noticed public meeting of ANC 3F with a quorum present (a quorum being four).

Starting January 1, 2013, Visitor Parking Passes that specify “only valid in ANC 3F” will no longer be valid for residents of the following blocks being redistricted from ANC 3F to ANC 3E:

38 th Street NW	4300-4600 blocks (boundary street – west side, even numbers only)
39 th Street NW	4200 block (boundary street – west side, even numbers only) 4300-4500 blocks (both sides of the street)
40 th Street NW	4200-4600 blocks (both sides of the street)
41 st Street NW	4200 block
Alton Place NW	3800-3900 blocks (both sides of the street)
Albemarle Street NW	3800-4000 blocks (both sides of the street)
Brandywine Street NW	3800 block (both sides of the street)
Chesapeake Street NW	3700 block (boundary street – north side, odd numbers only) 3800-3900 blocks (both sides of the street)
Cumberland Street NW	3700 block (both sides of the street)
Davenport Street NW	3700 block
Fort Drive, NW	4400-4600 blocks (no residences at this time)
Grant Road NW	3700 block, 4400-4600 blocks (both sides of the street)

Nebraska Avenue NW	4200-4800 blocks, and 4900 block up to Reno Road
Reno Road NW	4700-4900 blocks (boundary street – west side, even numbers only)
Van Ness Street NW	3900-4100 blocks (boundary street – north side, odd numbers only)
Veazey Street NW	3900-4000 blocks (both sides of the street)
Warren Street NW	3800 block (boundary street – north side, odd numbers only) 3900-4000 blocks (both sides of the street)
Windom Place NW	3800-3900 blocks (both sides of the street)
Wisconsin Avenue NW	4200-4500 blocks
Yuma Street NW	3800-3900 blocks (both sides of the street)
