**Resolution to Support the Bread Furst Application for a Great Streets Grant**

WHEREAS, the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development (DMPED) awards Great Streets Small Business Capital Improvement Grants of up to \$85,000, to reimburse small businesses in the city for capital expenditures intended to purchase and install heavy equipment or otherwise improve their place of business; and

WHEREAS, Remarkable Breads, LLC (d/b/a "Bread Furst"), a bakery-restaurant at 4434 Connecticut Ave NW, is seeking a Great Streets Small Grant to upgrade its exterior sidewalk cafe and interior cafe spaces and purchase three pieces of specialized equipment used in the production of its breads and pastries; and

WHEREAS, the ANC strongly supports the continued development of high-quality dining and retail options, such as Bread Furst, along the Van Ness commercial corridor; and

WHEREAS, the ANC 3F neighborhood has enthusiastically embraced Bread Furst since its opening in May 2014; and


WHEREAS, the ANC believes that the capital improvements proposed by Bread Furst will help expand business activity within the Van Ness commercial corridor by drawing more customers up to the less frequented area around Albemarle St.; and

WHEREAS, the ANC recognizes that Bread Furst will require permits from DC government agencies before proceeding with some of the proposed capital improvements;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3F strongly supports the Bread Furst application to DMPED for a Great Streets grant.
