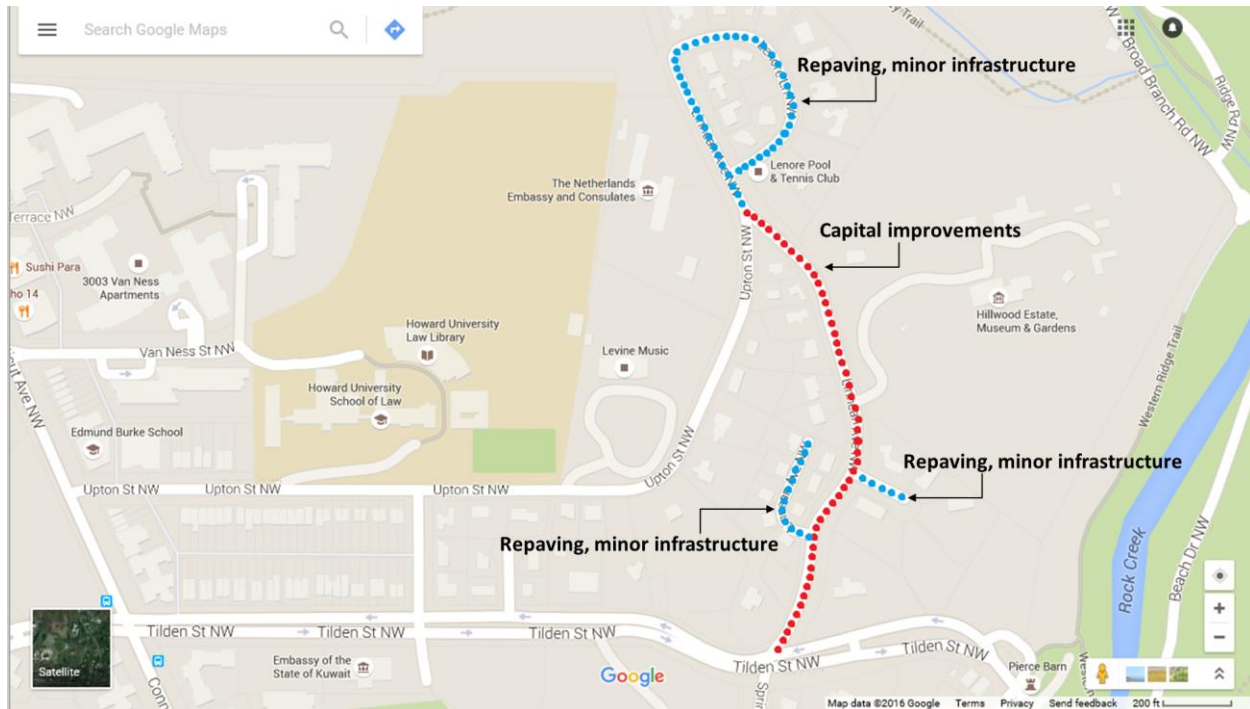


NEIGHBORHOOD PETITION TO DISTRICT DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DDOT)



Neighborhood map

We ask that DDOT, in consultation with the Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE)

- Develop a comprehensive plan for the streets highlighted in the neighborhood map, as follows:
 - For Linnean Avenue NW from 4001 to 4010 and from 4020 to 2500 Upton Street NW: capital improvements to improve storm water management, prevent erosion along the roadway and reconstruct the roadbed and pavement. Should this roadway improvement require installation of sidewalks, the neighborhood prefers that sidewalks be limited to one side of Linnean Avenue.
 - For Linnean Avenue NW from 4012 to 4024, Tilden Place NW, and Linnean Avenue NW from 4201 to 4209 and the 4200 block of Lenore Lane: street repaving and curb repair that does not require installation of sidewalks or, alternatively, that qualifies for a waiver from DDOT requirements regarding sidewalk installation within road reconstruction sites; and
- Study and, where appropriate, implement additional infrastructure improvements including Low Impact Development (LID) Construction, roundabouts and bio-retention areas.
- Commit to a schedule for the completion of design, required budget and construction and report those dates to the community.
- Meet with members of the community to explain designs and schedules. These meetings would be in addition to the regular presentation at an ANC 3F meeting. The community meeting will give residents an opportunity to understand the designs and their impact as a whole and provide feedback to DDOT prior to ANC's recommendation vote.

In addition, regarding some improvements that DDOT could make immediately without further study, we ask that DDOT staff schedule repaving of the most heavily damaged portions of Linnean Avenue.
