RESOLUTION REGARDING 2900 UPTON TRAFFIC CALMING PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION

October 17, 2017

WHEREAS, the neighborhood streets of the 2900 block Upton Street, NW have become an increasingly popular route for commuters attempting to travel to Connecticut Ave. NW, Tilden Street, N.W. and further east along Upton with heavy traffic and high speeds leading to concerns about safety for neighborhood residents; and

WHEREAS, this neighborhood serves as a home to Edmund Burke School, the Howard University School of Divinity, the Levine School of Music, numerous households with young children, a large concentration homes with pets, and other residents that generate consistent pedestrian and local vehicle traffic; and

WHEREAS, the speeds and traffic on Upton St., N.W. present a danger to residents, their pets and other users of the street; and

WHEREAS, the District of Columbia has prioritized transportation safety through efforts like Vision Zero and seeks to “eliminate fatalities and serious injuries to travelers of our transportation system” by 2024; and

NOTING, that residents along the 2900 block of Upton Street, N.W. and the parallel block of Tilden Street, N.W. have expressed their desire for traffic calming measures to be implemented along their street by signing a petition in support of such a measure:


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC 3F requests that the District Department of Transportation (DDOT):

1. Study and provide recommendations regarding the most effective and appropriate traffic calming measures to improve the safety of pedestrians, cyclists and motorists along the 2900 block of Upton St., NW.;
2. Present these traffic solutions and recommendations at a later meeting of the ANC or a special community meeting for neighborhood residents;
3. Implement these traffic solutions and recommendations as soon as possible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Commissioner Jakopchek is authorized to speak on behalf of

ANC 3F regarding this matter.

ANC 3F PASSED this resolution at its meeting on October 17, 2017, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining.
