ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 3F

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RESOLUTION CALLING FOR CONTINUED DDOT IMPROVEMENTS TO STREETScape OF LINNEAN AVENUE, TILDEN PLACE, LINNEAN AVENUE AND LENORE LANE

WHEREAS ANC 3F is tasked with considering a wide range of policies and programs affecting its neighborhoods, including traffic, parking, and street improvements by § 1–309.10(a) of the Code of the District of Columbia, and

WHEREAS the residents of the affected neighborhoods have requested repaving and infrastructure improvements to their streetscape, as demonstrated by a petition signed by a majority of residents, and

WHEREAS the current condition of the affected neighborhoods poses hazards to residents, property, visitors and neighboring areas including Soapstone Valley Park, and

WHEREAS ANC 3F unanimously passed an earlier resolution related the streetscape of the affected neighborhoods in July, 2016, and

EXPRESSING ITS GRATITUDE to the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) for the initial repaving project completed along the 4000 and 4100 blocks of Linnean Avenue NW in November, 2016, and

EMPHASIZING that additional aspects of the streetscape improvement project incorporated within the July, 2016 resolution and further repaving are still necessary for the affected areas,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3F requests that the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), in consultation with the Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE):

- Repave the roadway and repair curbs on Tilden Place NW, and Linnean Avenue NW from 4201 to 4209 and the 4200 block of Lenore Lane NW as soon as possible;
- Prepare and present a Scoping, ADA and Conceptual (15%) Plan for Linnean Avenue NW from 4001 to 4010 and from 4020 to 2500 Upton Street NW to improve storm water management, prevent erosion along the roadway and protect the roadbed and pavement;
- Recognize that, should roadway improvements between Upton and Tilden streets NW require installation of sidewalks along this portion of Linnean Avenue, the neighborhood prefers that sidewalks be limited to one side of Linnean Avenue;
- Study and, where appropriate, implement additional infrastructure improvements including Low Impact Development (LID) techniques to capture stormwater as close to the source as possible;
- Prepare and present a preliminary budget estimate and identify public easements in in the affected area no later than February 28, 2018;
- Continue to meet with members of the community, ANC 3F and Councilwoman Cheh’s office to explain designs and schedules, solicit comments, and finalize the design to incorporate neighborhood feedback.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Commissioners Jakopchek and _____ are authorized to speak on behalf of ANC 3F regarding this matter.
