**RESOLUTION: Appropriations for the University of the District of Columbia (UDC); Fiscal Year  
2019**

[February 20, 2018]

WHEREAS,

The University of the District of Columbia (UDC) is a pacesetter in urban education that offers affordable and effective undergraduate, graduate, professional, and workplace learning opportunities. The institution is the premier gateway to postsecondary education and research for all residents of the District of Columbia. As a public, historically black, and land-grant institution, the University's responsibility is to build a diverse generation of competitive, civically engaged scholars and leaders.

WHEREAS,

Both Mayor Bowser and UDC have acknowledged that the "Equity Imperatives" of Washington, DC includes education as a priority and a gateway to the middle class, and that Washington, DC continues to invest in the public education of its children by dedicating significant resources to its capital budget for school renovations.

WHEREAS,

UDC represents the best opportunity to fulfil the equity imperative for many DC residents to achieve their full academic, professional, and/or technical training in order to reach the middle class and to fulfill their individual and societal potential.

WHEREAS,

UDC represents a fundamental opportunity for residents in all eight (8) wards and a vital educational and cultural link in our neighborhoods throughout the district, including the ANC3F area.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that ANC 3F:

1. Agrees with Mayor Bowser and UDC that equity imperatives are a priority and that education is a fundamental pathway to the middle class.
  
2. Recommends that Mayor Bowser and her budget team fully assess and support the equity imperative budget proposals presented by UDC for fiscal year 2019, and fully evaluate the

need for appropriate operating and capital budgets in a strategic way over the next ten (10) years.

3. Recommends that DC City Council assess and support the equity imperative budget proposals presented by UDC for fiscal year 2019, and fully evaluate the need for appropriate operating and capital budgets in a strategic way over the next ten (10) years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Commissioners Dickinson and Adelstein are authorized to speak on behalf of ANC 3F regarding this matter.

ANC 3F passed this resolution at its meeting on February 20, 2018, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 6 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining (6-0-0).
