**Resolution in Support of Sidwell Friends School (“Sidwell” or “School”) Request for Time
Extension for BZA Order 17703A**

[April 17, 2018]

WHEREAS,

Sidwell, the applicant for a special exception to increase the size of the existing School’s campus to include Lot 818 in Square 1825 (the “Property”), seeks a two-year extension of BZA Order No. 17703A to April 1, 2020.

WHEREAS,

ANC3F has previously adopted a Resolution on February 23, 2016, that supported the Sidwell BZA Application (No. 17703A), with several recommendations regarding raised sidewalks, traffic, student/faculty caps, aesthetics, construction and parking.

WHEREAS,


Neighbors in the immediate vicinity of Sidwell and within ANC3F have worked successfully to resolve issues related to Sidwell’s initial application in 2016 and have not raised any objections to ANC3F regarding the two-year extension of BZA Order No. 17703A.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3F:

1. Supports the Sidwell application for a two-year extension of BZA Order No. 17703A.
2. Recommends to the Department of Transportation that it conduct, review, and provide of full public participation in a traffic study that examines the impacts of the Sidwell expansion, Heart Park renovation, the construction project at 4000 Wisconsin, and the construction project at 3900 Wisconsin and the numerous concerns about traffic flows on main corridors as well as adjacent side streets including 37th Street, Van Ness Street, Upton and Tilden Streets, Wisconsin Avenue, and streets on the west side of Wisconsin Avenue.
3. Continues to support, and incorporates by reference herein, the recommendations made in its February 23, 2016 Resolution regarding Sidwell’s BZA special exception application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Commissioners Dickinson and Jakopchek are authorized to speak on behalf of ANC 3F regarding this matter.

ANC 3F passed this resolution at its meeting on April 17, 2018, which was properly noticed and at which a quorum was present, by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstaining ~~(-)~~.
