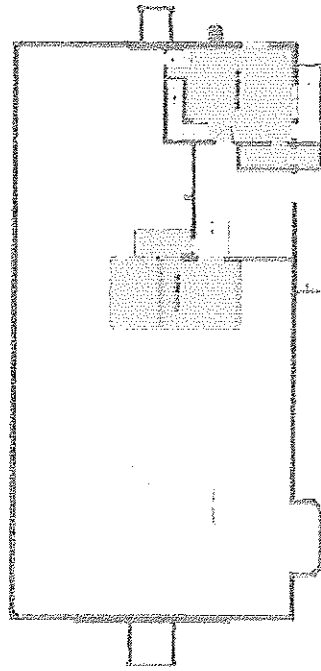
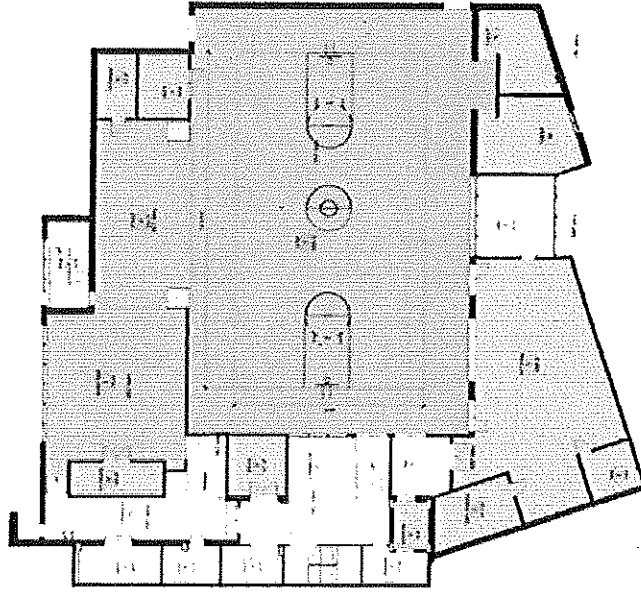
The Hearst Elementary PTA is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization designed, in part, to enhance the education and cultural experiences of its approximately 295 students from the pre-k through 5<sup>th</sup> grade levels. Hearst Elementary is located within the physical boundary of ANC3F. Hearst Elementary completed the renovation of its existing building of classrooms in the summer of 2014. Hearst Elementary is undergoing the construction of approximately 10 new classrooms with completion expected by the end of 2014. The 3<sup>rd</sup> phase of modernization includes the construction of a new cafeteria/gymnasium which will include both a stage and adjacent music room (along with a library, computer room, science/art room, etc). The 3<sup>rd</sup> phase of construction is expected to be complete by August 2015. Attached is a rendition of the 3<sup>rd</sup> phase. With the modernization completed in the summer of 2014 came the addition of a 2-story trailer complex that includes a cafeteria which is used for group functions such as drama/dance, and indoor recess.

The Hearst Elementary Local School Advisory Team (LSAT) identified a number of areas of improvement based upon community input – including the addition of a full-time music teacher commencing with the 2014-2015 school year (the hiring is occurring now). Hearst Elementary has previously used such sources as the Filmore Arts Center, Sidwell Middle School, as well as a private vendor to supply music, dance, and drama instruction. With the addition of a music teacher (as well as an existing art teacher) the program will be developed internally to Hearst.

In coordination with the Music Teacher, Hearst Elementary will develop a music/choir program available for all grade levels in the Fall of 2014. It is anticipated the grant funding will cover items such as xylophones, music sheets and songbooks, drum sets, other instruments (e.g. recorders), and physical apparatus such as music stands and staging. The following are cost estimates subject to concurrence of the Music Teacher: recorders - \$5/each – up to 300 pieces; xylophones - \$75/each- up to 10-20 pieces; drum sets - \$15/each – up to 10 pieces; music/songbooks - \$5/each – up to 40/50 pieces. The Hearst Elementary PTA will provide an initial cost itemization by September 30, 2014 and monthly itemizations (as needed) for additional expenditures with an expectation that all funds will be spent by the end of 2014.
