**ANC 3F Resolution Regarding Modifications
to the Bread Furst Sidewalk Cafe**

WHEREAS, in May, 2014, Remarkable Breads LLC, doing business as Bread Furst, received a public space permit to operate an unenclosed sidewalk cafe at the premises 4434 Connecticut Avenue, NW, which is within the boundaries of ANC 3F; and

WHEREAS, ANC 3F unanimously supported that application at its meeting in April, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Bread Furst subsequently submitted to DDOT a modification to its original sidewalk cafe plans, adding two square sun shade umbrellas measuring 9'9" on a side and an exterior trellis along the southern edge of the cafe measuring 5'6" high by 15' wide, with a requested height variance for the trellis of up to 9';

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3F

- 1) *supports* the addition of two sun shade umbrellas measuring 9'9" on a side, secured by a moveable concrete base and without any commercial advertising, to the Bread Furst sidewalk cafe; and
- 2) also *supports* the requested height variance and installation of a trellis up to 9' high in the existing moveable planters along the southern edge of the Bread Furst sidewalk cafe, as described in the modified cafe plan.

This resolution was approved by a vote of six (6) in favor, one (1) opposed, and none (0) abstaining from voting at a duly noticed public meeting of ANC 3F on the 17th day of June, 2014. Commissioner Nugent is delegated authority to represent ANC 3F in this matter.
