3. Resolution Urging DDOT to Address Dangerous Traffic Safety Conditions in Forest Hills. This is a resolution urging DDOT to address dangerous traffic safety conditions in Forest Hills as identified in the memorandum dated January 21, 2022 and supplemented by the sidewalks petition dated January 29, 2022. 4. Resolution in support of accelerated and additional traffic calming measures for Connecticut Avenue. This is a resolution requesting DDOT to implement, as soon as possible, a full range of safety improvements to make Connecticut Avenue safe for all forms of travel (a follow-up to the Connecticut Avenue Reversible Lane & Safety Study).
