ANC 3F Resolution Regarding Van Ness Main Street Participation in 2022 Art All Night, Friday, September 23, 2022)

WHEREAS Art All Night is a festival that celebrates visual and performing arts in Washington DC, including painting, photography, sculpture, crafts, fashion, music, dance, theater, film, and poetry. The festival takes place in 20 different Main Street corridors and is held in both indoor and outdoor public and private spaces, including businesses;

WHEREAS 2022 is Van Ness Main Street’s third contribution to Art All Night. 16 neighborhoods were part of the last city-wide festival pre-pandemic. The festival is likely to bring 3,000-4,000 visitors to Van Ness, Forest Hills, and Wakefield. Participation is intended to reinforce Van Ness Main Street as a lively destination for neighbors and visitors;

WHEREAS the current overview of the event includes:

- Seven performance activations up and down the corridor from Van Ness Street to Nebraska Avenue
- Pop Up Gallery Market in the lower corridor from 6:00 pm to 11 pm in front of UDC’s law school, Gold’s Gym and the former Wells Fargo space (4340 and 4310 Conn Ave) in same fashion as our Spring and Holiday Pop Up Markets
- Final Movie Night in the UDC Amphitheater at 8 pm
- Pop Up Art Galleries at the former Wells Fargo, Bank of America, and Acacia spaces (4302, 4201, and 4340 Conn Ave)
- Children’s author event in front of Politics and Prose
