AGENDA ITEMS

1. Approval of Regular Agenda and Consent Agenda

Agenda was presented for approval with the addition of the letter of support for fully funding Vision Zero as item #2 on the regular agenda. The consent agenda item is the June Meeting minutes. Commissioner Appah moves to approve the agenda. The agenda is approved by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions (5-0-0).

2. Commissioner Updates

Treasurer's Report: ANC 3F has a balance of \$46,449 which reflects the recovery of funds of from December which were lost due to fraudulent activity. We are in good shape. There will be a more detailed report in September when we close out the quarter.

Commissioner Nemeth: Nothing specific for 3F06 to report. James Tandaric has been appointed as Commissioner for 3F07. He is currently on vacation and will be sworn in upon his return. We will have our full Commission seated in September.

Commissioner Cristeal: As James Tandaric is an incoming Commissioner now, we will be searching for a new chair for the Schools & Universities Committee.

1. Grant Application: Feed the Pantry DC

- A grant application was received in the amount of \$1,996 to support the pantries activities. Commissioner Nemeth moves to approve the resolution. The motion is approved by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions (5-0-0).

2. Letter of Support for Fully Funding Vision Zero

- A letter was drafted via our Streets & Sidewalks Committee requesting DC Council fully fund Vision Zero. Streets & Sidewalks has been discussing Vision Zero for months. DC Council is considering using Automated Traffic Enforcement (ATEs) to fund Vision Zero initiative. Commissioner Nemeth moves to approve the resolution. The motion is approved by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed, and 0 abstentions (5-0-0)

3. Committee Reports

Streets and Sidewalks (Bob Deyling): There was not much to report. The committee met in early June. Continues to monitor Conn Ave Study. Made recommendations about sidewalks. Commissioner Nemeth asked if the Committee has heard anything about what is to happen with streeteries now that rush hour restrictions are going to be imposed again. The committee has not heard any updates.

4. Community Forum

- Phillip Waggoner – Following up on the parking issue that was previously raised by him. DCRA, et al. seem to believe that it is the ANC that negotiates this issue. Where do we

stand with the issue? Commissioner Cristeal responded that in researching the Hearst Pool project, he could find no records regarding parking negotiations. He has not heard back from ANC 3C regarding any negotiations they may have had regarding Hearst Park Pool or the development at City Ridge where the Wegmans is going.

5. Adjournment

Commissioner Appah moved to adjourn. Motion was approved with 5 voting in favor, 0 voting against, and 0 abstaining (5-0-0). The meeting adjourned at 8:35pm.
